

**Resolution**  
**Of the Seventh National Forum “Transformation of Ukraine”**  
**«Presentation of the draft Concept of the National Strategy for Transformation of**  
**Ukraine»**

Participants of the National Forum “Transformation of Ukraine” confirm the main goals and tasks regarding implementation of the National Strategy for Transformation of Ukraine as a unifying agenda for the country, based on the modern technology of achieving the Copenhagen criteria and national interests of Ukraine.

In an effort to turn Ukraine into a successful European state, intending to immediately start the process of preparation and implementation of the National Strategy for Transformation of Ukraine (NSTU), participants of the National Forum “Transformation of Ukraine”

decided upon the following:

1. To support the Concept of the Strategy for Transformation of Ukraine, taking into account the proposals, as an initiative of the civil society of Ukraine.

2. To address the President, the Government, political forces of Ukraine, public organizations, international partners regarding development of a joint National Strategy for Transformation of Ukraine.

3. To appeal to the G-7 and other friendly states with a proposal to support the NFTU's initiative to establish the International Coordination Mechanism for Ukraine (ICMU) as a pre-condition to development of a joint comprehensive transformational strategy between the West and Ukraine.

4. To promote creation of the American Committee on Support of the Transformation of Ukraine, which may include well-known political and public figures in the United States, as well as leading organizations in the field of Ukrainian-American cooperation.

5. To continue work on the creation of the Inter-Parliamentary Forum “Transformation of Ukraine”. It is expected that it will include representatives of both pro-government and opposition deputies from parliaments of friendly countries.

6. To continue to develop and detail the comprehensive Action Plan on preparation of the NSTU jointly and with participation of all interested parties.
